Proposed Timeline

| Primer/Gloss? | I think the surface should be primed with Acrylic Gesso. Up to you if you want gloss or finish. | Up to \$50 for gesso. |
| Paint | Colors: Primaries (Red, Yellow, Blue), Black, White, Yellow Ochre, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Violet, Vermillion, etc. Depending on the final design, I'll need more or less of some colors. | Majority of supply budget. Quality of paint is most important. \$15-\$30 per gallon of paint (Brand: Rhino Shield. Seems to be a very long lasting paint. Open to other brands.) |
| Brushes/Rollers | Variations of large rollers to quickly cover areas with paint. Flat brushes around 6" more or less. I have some brushes of my own to reduce costs. | \$30-\$50 variety pack |
| PVC Panels | Not sure what the plan is for this. | Unsure of Cost because I'm not sure what plan is. |
