Questions to consider as you review and choose your top 5 choices.

- What did you like best at first view of their design?
 - What did you dislike?
 - Would the design compliment the look and feel of Warner?
 - Is there more to their design the longer you study it, or is there "more than meets the eye"?
 - Have they done mural work before? Was it well done?
 - Do they have a reasonable timeline?
 - Did one of these designs more successfully incorporate Warner's history?

Judging Guidelines for Interviews

Suggested Interview Questions

- Tell us about your design.
- Why do you want to create this project?
- What is your plan for getting this mural completed?
- How can you reassure us of the mural's light fastness & durability?
- When would you be able to finish the mural?
- Is there anything else you would like to add?
- What is your estimated budget for the project? (There is up to \$2,000 allowed for materials, and up to \$6,000 for design and labor.)

Final Design Considerations

- Is the final design presented professionally? Clean artwork, no rips, tears or wrinkles or bad lighting.
- Did they consider the space it will be in, how large it would be and the dimensions that they can work within?
