Artistic Vision

For the mural at 2 E Main St. I imagine a design 8' by 32', using eight 4'x8' panels. I was originally planning a sort of triptych style with four separate 8' square pieces. After arranging the sketch superimposed onto the wall I decided it would look much more appealing mounted together as one long design. The placement of the stop sign along the side of the building affects how the mural would look if it were placed too far forward towards main street.

My design would be centered around the Warner river, with the river flowing horizontally through all 32' feet of the mural. Along the river would be a timeline in imagery of warner's history, starting with the initial agriculture of the region on the far left.

Artistic Vision Cont.

Next would be the mill buildings and industry of the 1800s, then the snow trains of mid 1900's, and ending in modern times focusing on maple sugaring with Kearsarge mountain prominent in the background.

I'd like to include as many New Hampshire, and Warner specific things as I can. If chosen to do a final sketch I would be able to spend more time researching at the historical society to make sure everything is as accurate as possible. I would also be able to do a color study. I included a very rudimentary color study in this application, but only to show a rough idea of what it could look like. The exact colors are very likely to change.

Artistic Vision Cont.

I plan on having each panel not only progress in time, but also in seasons. The left most panels would be Summer, moving on to reach Spring at the far right. I would keep this effect as subtle as I can, but I think Warner is a very season-driven town and if I picked just one season to depict the town in I would be missing out on a lot of our story.

To speed up the timeline on this project I would not be working alone. I have enlisted the help of a fellow artist named Christopher Brewer. He is based in Concord NH and does stunning work.
